General Information

Parking

As parking is limited in the area surrounding the school, the challenge is to provide a parking plan that meets the needs of our participants and complies with all of the state laws. In general, we **MUST** follow all posted parking regulations both on private property and on the public roadway. We also want to provide a smooth entrance and exit for all concerned.

Public/Performer Parking/Drum Major Entrance (Valley Oak Lane)

Performers and Drum Majors will enter in the Valley Oak Lane entrance. There will be guides to lead you where to go. Drum Major parking will be on the black top close to the Football Stadium, we call this the DRUM MAJOR ZONE. The public may also park in the student lot, located off Valley Oak Lane. There will be a designated area for public parking.

A portion of the lot will be roped off for use by the participants. All parking is on a first come, first served basis. No vehicles will be allowed to block any portion of the aisles or park in fire lanes or loading zones. This area will not be managed by show volunteers.

No parking is allowed on Elk Grove-Florin Road. Parking is allowed on Valley Oak Lane as posted. All parking regulations will be enforced by local law enforcement.

Handicap and Judges Parking (Elk Grove-Florin Road)

Handicap parking and NCBA Judges will park at the school entrance on Elk Grove-Florin Road. Please arrive with all of your vehicles.

Parking for these vehicles is very limited so please plan accordingly. Only vehicles with parking passes will be allowed into this area with a maximum of four vehicles per group.

ALL OTHER VEHICLES MUST PARK IN THE PUBLIC PARKING AREA

All of these vehicles will be directed to a specific area for parking. Due to the high number of participants, show personnel will make the final decision as to where these vehicles will be parked.

Director Check In

Registration will be located in the band room G3 Director's Lounge. Each school will need to send a representative to check in. At this time the director/head instructor will receive wrist bands and ALL ACCESS badges. Please give the wrist bands to staff/students only. All parents and non-participating students must pay the admission fees. Please complete the announcer's sheet at this time.

Warm Up Area for WP / WG

We have designated warm up areas for use. Please follow all warning signs for silent zones. If the weather is acceptable, you may warm up in your designated parking area. We have one indoor warm up area. This indoor area will have scheduled times so that all groups have equal access. We also have a large basketball courtyard black top where you can rehearse with your floor mats and have some extension cords to plug in electronics. We will do our best to accommodate all groups.

We will move the Drum Major competition in the warm-up area (South Gym) if it rains.

Restroom and Locker Facilities

We will have our men's and women's locker rooms open for your use. These areas are attached to the gym (competition zone) and are in close proximity to your parking areas. These facilities have restroom areas inside. Please send a same sex chaperone with your performers when using the locker rooms.

We have restrooms available inside the main quad area of the campus.

Announcer's Sheets

Please turn in your announcers sheets at the sound check table.

Food

We will provide a good selection of food for purchase by participants and spectators. The food booths will be located just off the public entrance on the south side of Cartwright Gym.

Please visit our director's lounge for food and a place to relax. No students are allowed.

Show Entrance

The competition will be held in the Cartwright Gym. The performer entrance for this gym is located on the north side, which are accessed through the main courtyard. These doors are the only doors wide enough to accommodate equipment trailers and are sheltered from the elements. Ticket sales will be located outside the south doors.

Performing groups will need to stage in the hallway outside the participant entrance before the prior group finishes. The groups can then move through this doorway as quickly as possible when time allows.

Sound Check

The only time for sound checks will be before the competition or during breaks. Please bring your tape directly to the sound table. Please make sure that your cassette or CD is clearly labeled and that cassettes are performance ready.

Score Packets –Pick them up at the Director's Meeting (see schedule)

Score sheet packets will be handed out before each award ceremony. Each director will have five minutes to check their scores and recaps. **After the five minute period, the results are final.**

Awards Ceremony

Only one uniformed member per performing unit may be allowed on the floor to accept awards. This is in compliance with NCBA rules and regulations.

Sportsmanship

Any group not displaying respect for themselves or others will be removed from the competition area.

Security

We cannot guarantee the safety of any equipment, instruments, or personal belongings. We encourage you to provide your own security. PLEASE do not leave anything in the dressing rooms.

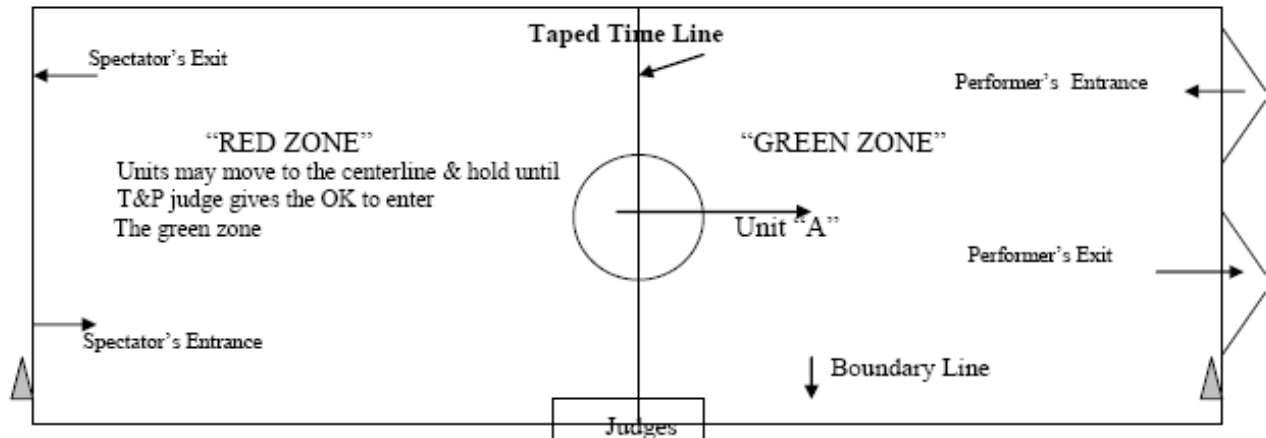
Cleanliness

Please clean up after your groups. We will be collecting garbage at regular intervals.

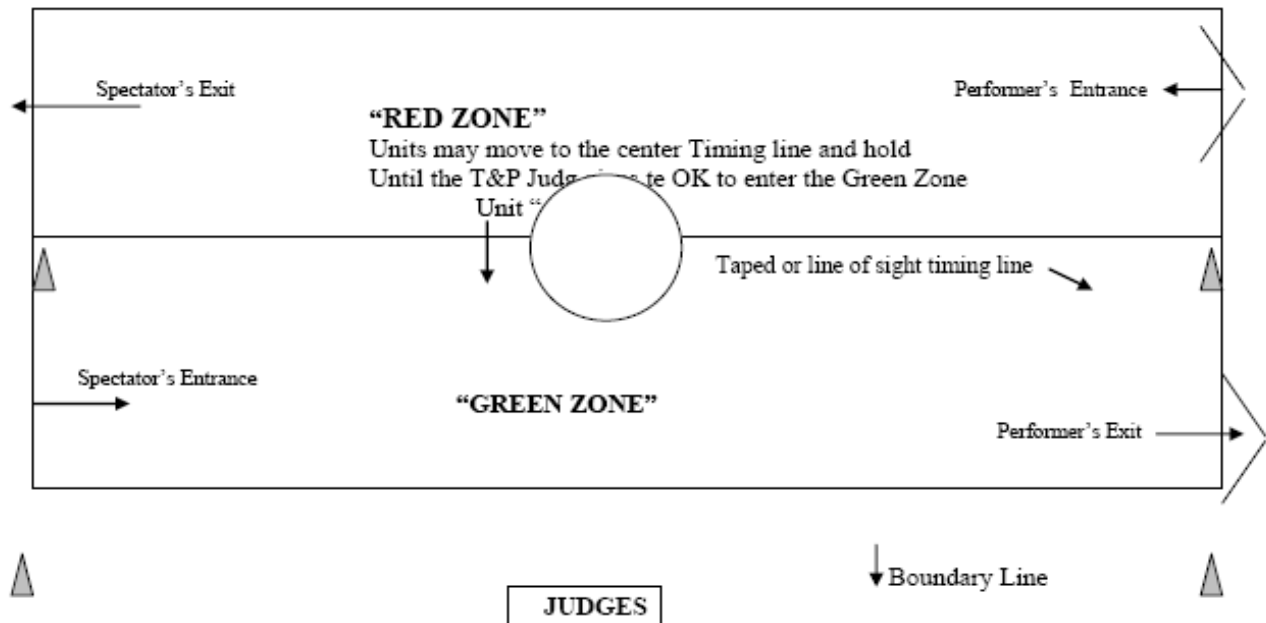
Performers Entrance and Exit Information

A units total 10-minute time for set up, perform and exit will start and stop when the unit crosses the marked centerline either vertical or horizontal.

Directions to Elk Grove High School



From the intersection of SR99 and Elk Grove Boulevard, go east on Elk Grove Boulevard. Upon reaching the intersection of Elk Grove Boulevard and Elk Grove-Florin Road, go south on Elk Grove-Florin Road. The school is located at **9800** Elk Grove-Florin Road.

From SR 99 South, exit on Elk Grove Boulevard. Turn left and go over the overpass. Make the first right onto East Stockton Blvd. Turn Left onto Valley Oak. Follow Valley Oak to parking lot. Enter the school parking lot on the right.

From SR 99 North, exit Elk Grove Blvd. At the stop sign, turn right onto East Stockton Blvd. Turn Left onto Valley Oak. Follow Valley Oak to parking lot. Enter the school parking lot on the right.

Awards Ceremony Guidelines

Trophy Acceptance

Trophies for bands and all other units must be accepted at the awards ceremony by a **fully uniformed** member of the winning band. The uniform worn at the awards ceremony **MUST** be one that truly represents the school involved. *Schools are limited to sending only one (1) representative for each competing unit to the awards ceremony.* All Drum Majors and Captains who participate in the awards ceremony are expected to stand during the entire presentation. Salutes given by the awards personnel should be dignified and respectful. *No lounge chairs will be permitted and any unit or individual who displays poor sportsmanship or behaves in such a manner as to demean or degrade the awards ceremony will be asked to leave the awards presentation area.*

Awards Ceremony

The awards ceremony is the highlight of the band event that has just concluded. Band members, friends, parents, boosters, and supporters are reminded that while in the awards area they will be expected to display proper behavior and good sportsmanship at all times. No throwing of any objects will be allowed. Nothing that squirts or shoots will be allowed. *Any individual, group, or organization that behaves in such a manner as to demean or degrade the awards ceremony, demean or degrade another person or unit, or behaves in such a way as to cause injury to any other person or property will be asked to leave the awards presentation area.*

Community Relations

Several *NCBA* events have reported an increased incidence of vandalism both on and off campus. Fires in the locker rooms, broken windows, fights, drug and/or alcohol use, and theft have been reported at several locations. Many local businesses report an increase in shoplifting during the time when visiting bands are present. Please caution your students that this type of behavior jeopardizes the ability of the hosting unit to continue to make this opportunity available for everyone.
